# IPL 2024: Ravi Shastri backs Impact Player rule amid debate

- **Former India coach Ravi Shastri has backed the Impact Player rule**
- **Shastri said the IPL rule has contributed to number of thrilling finishes**
- **BCCI Secretary Jay Shah said that the Impact Player rule was not permanent**



all-rounders in India. Rohit, the first prominent Indian player to voice concerns about the rule, pointed out that it was introduced in the IPL in 2023 after a trial in the domestic Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy T20 tournament. The rule permits teams to substitute a 12th player at any point during the match, replacing one of the original XI announced at the toss. "The Impact Player [rule] is good. You have to evolve with the times," Shastri told R Ashwin on his YouTube channel. "You know, it happens in

other sports as well. It's got tighter finishes. You have to evolve with the times and I think it's a good rule. You saw the number of tight finishes we had in last year's IPL. So, you know, it has made a big difference." While some, including India captain Rohit Sharma, believe the rule hinders the development of all-rounders, others see its benefits. For example, Ashwin highlighted Dhruv Jurel, who started his IPL career as an Impact Player in 2023 and made his Test debut for India within a year. "You know

when any new rule comes in, there will be people who will try and justify why that's not right," Shastri said. "But in time when you see the scores - 200 and 190 - and then like you mentioned individuals grabbing that opportunity and making the most of it, people will start re-looking at how they think about it." The BCCI Secretary Jay Shah said the Impact Player rule was "not permanent" and that a decision on its use in future IPL editions will be made following a conversation with stakeholders after the T20 World Cup 2024. "Impact Player is like a test case. We have implemented it slowly. The biggest advantage of it is that two Indian players are getting a chance [in each game], which is the most important," Shah had told reporters at the BCCI headquarters in Mumbai on Thursday. "We will consult with the players, franchises, broadcasters [and take a call]. This is not permanent [but] I am not saying that it will go. [We'll see] if it's making the game more competitive or not. Even then, if a player feels that this is not right, then we will talk to them. But no one has told us anything yet, so it will be decided after the World Cup."

## I am curious: Justin Langer on prospect of becoming the next coach of Indian team

**New Delhi** LSG head coach Justin Langer is curious about the Indian team's head coach position. Speaking to the Times of India ahead of their match against DC, Langer said the Indian head coach position is an extraordinary role. The Board of Control for Cricket in India invited applications on 13 May with Rahul Dravid's tenure coming to an end after the T20 World Cup 2024. Langer said that he had deep respect for the coaches of any international team as he knew that it was a very difficult job. Langer said that the head coach's role in India will be fascinating due to the massive talent pool.



"Well, I am curious. I've never ever thought about it. I have deep respect for any international coach because I understand the pressure, but coaching the Indian team

would be an extraordinary role. From what I've seen with the amount of talent I've seen in this country, it would be fascinating," Langer told TOI in an

interview. Langer coached Australia to a T20 World Cup win in 2021, and then Ashes win in the very same season. Langer said that it was a hell and heaven difference between the jobs of a coach and an assistant coach. "I went straight from playing to coaching - as an assistant coach, which is the best coach job in the world. You work about two hours a day, everyone's your best friend, and you've got no accountability. Then you become head coach, oh man, then you work about 16 hours a day. No one likes you. And you've got 100% accountability!" Langer concluded.

## Gambhir reveals his only regret at KKR: Not using Suryakumar to full potential

- **KKR mentor Gautam Gambhir has revealed that his only regret KKR captain is that he was not able to use Suryakumar Yadav to his full potential. Suryakumar left KKR ahead of the 2018 season.**



**New Delhi.** KKR mentor Gautam Gambhir has spoken about his one and only regret during his time as the captain of the franchise. Gambhir, who led KKR to two IPL titles in 2012 and 2014 said that his only regret in his time at KKR is that he was not able to bring the best out of Suryakumar Yadav.

Suryakumar was KKR's designated finisher between 2014-2017. Suryakumar showed glimpses of brilliance and many argued that the batter should be brought up the batting order. Due to the packed batting line-up, Suryakumar was not able to get that

chance and asked to be released by the franchise. Suryakumar joined back MI in 2018 and became one of the best batters in the Indian Premier League. "A leader's role is to identify the best potential and show it to the world. If there is one regret I have in my seven years of captaincy is that me and as a team never managed to use Suryakumar Yadav to the best of his potential,"

Gambhir told Sportskeeda in an interview. IPL 2024 Full Coverage | IPL 2024 Points Table and Standings | 2024 IPL Full Schedule "And the reason was down to combinations. You can only play one player at No. 3. And as a leader, you have to think about the other 10 players in the XI as well. He would have been way more effective at No. 3, but was equally good at No. 7," he added. Suryakumar Yadav made his India debut after playing for MI. The batter rose rapidly in the cricketing world and conquered the No. 1 spot in the ICC's list of top T20I batters. Suryakumar captained the Indian team in 2023 and did surprisingly well. The Indian team will have high hopes from Surya in the T20 World Cup 2024. India have selected an experienced squad and are one of the favourites to lift the T20 World Cup title.

## India doing well, hopefully we can qualify for Women's T20 World Cup semis: Harmanpreet

**New Delhi** Skipper Harmanpreet Kaur is confident that the Indian women's team will be amongst the semi-finalists in this year's T20 World Cup. Harmanpreet believes that defeating the 'Southern Stars' will be crucial in securing India's first global title. The T20 World Cup is scheduled to take place in Bangladesh from October 3-20, with Harmanpreet counting on the Indian team's familiarity with the conditions to boost their chances. India were drawn in Group A alongside six-time champions Australia, New Zealand, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka for the tournament's ninth edition. Group B includes South Africa, England, 2016 champions West Indies, Bangladesh, and Scotland.

"India, Australia, England and South Africa. Because all these teams have been doing really well and hopefully these four can qualify for the semis so we can have very

good cricket over there. I think it will be Australia (who I look forward to facing) because they are very competitive," Harmanpreet told ICC during a fixture launch event. Though Harmanpreet's team has challenged Australian dominance recently, their opponents have emerged victorious in global competitions, winning the Women's T20 World Cup final in 2020 and the Commonwealth Games final in 2022. Australia also beat India in the 2023 T20 World Cup semifinals. "If we do well against them, it will give us a lot of confidence and I'm really looking forward to playing against them," she added.



Harmanpreet also believed India's performance in the recently finished 5-match series against the hosts has made them more accustomed to the conditions. "Yeah, it's a bit similar to India and hopefully, in these

conditions, we should do well." India and Bangladesh have had a heated rivalry in recent years, which was on full display during the recently ended series. Since the 2023 T20 World Cup, India has visited Bangladesh twice: in July last year for a three-match T20I series and an ODI series, and most recently for a five-match T20I series. "Bangladesh will be the home team and they will know the conditions better than us. Obviously crowd will be supporting them. But playing against them is always an exciting event. And hopefully, we will do well against them," said Harmanpreet. On India's so-near-yet-so-far experience in World Cups, Harmanpreet said, "I think in all the ICC events we have done well. The only thing is that we have lost a lot of close games. And this time hopefully all those close games if we can win and do well for the team."
