Shinde takes a dig at Uddhav Thackeray over his meeting with CM Fadnavis

Nagpur, Dec 18 (IANS) Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Wednesday took a dig at Shiv Sena-UBT chief Uddhav Thackeray over his meeting with Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, saying it was like "meet this one, meet that one and go home next day." He thereby downplayed the meeting between Thackeray and Fadnavis. "Anyone can meet the Chief Minister. The Chief Minister is the head of the state. The opposition party also meets him. The leaders of other parties of the opposition party also meet him. I see a radical change in those who criticised him severely, talked about ending him, and talked about putting him in jail. It

is not wrong to meet Devendra Fadnavis," said Shinde. On the other hand, Shiv Sena legislator and former minister Deepak Kesarkar said "If Uddhav Thackeray had held such a meeting earlier (with Devendra Fadnavis), Shiv Sena would not have been divided into two." Earlier, Uddhav Thackeray had not even responded to Devendra Fadnavis' telephonic calls. Uddhav Thackeray abandoned Balasaheb Thackeray's idea of Hindutva for the post of Chief Minister. Eknath Shinde had no other demand. Eknath Shinde's only demand was that we should go with the idea of Hindutva. We should not go with the Congress. But if Uddhav Thackeray had

met Devendra Fadnavis then, all this would not have happened. Devendra Fadnavis called Uddhav Thackeray many times in 2019. But now it is too late. Now the MahaYuti government has come back to power again," said Kesarkar. Meanwhile, Shinde slammed the opposition for their campaign against EVMs, saying that "When the poll results go against them, allegations are made against EVMs." "When the results are in favour of the Maha Vikas Aghadi, then EVMs are good. For them, the Election Commission is good. The Supreme Court and the High Court are also good. When the results are against them, then they start blaming EVMs. The

opposition has been doing this for the last few days. In 2004 and 2009, voting was done on EVMs and the Congress won. When you win, you praise that system," he added. "Even the Supreme Court said that when you win, you don't come to us and when you lose, you come to us. This is a double standard. After winning the Lok Sabha elections, you (the opposition) didn't talk about EVMs. Omar Abdullah has also slammed the Congress," said Eknath Shinde. He said that Congress should not insult the mandate otherwise the people will make them sit at home. Shinde also ridiculed Uddhav Thackeray for his demand that the appointment of Election Commissioner be made through election.

Mentally ill naked man enters ladies compartment of local train

Mumbai, Dec 18 (UNI): A mentally ill naked man entered the ladies' compartment of a Mumbai local train and was immediately deboarded, a railway official said here on Wednesday. The incident occurred around 4 p.m. on Monday evening, sparking panic and anger among passengers.

The man entered the compartment from Ghatkopar railway station when the AC local was travelling from Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) to Kalyan.

Immediately the woman passengers alerted the train and the ticket checker who was in an adjoining compartment rushed to the spot and brought the man out of the train.

CEC reviews poll preparedness for Delhi assembly election

New Delhi, Dec 18 (UNI) Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar, along with Election Commissioners Gyanesh Kumar and Dr. Sandhu on Wednesday reviewed the poll preparedness for the upcoming Delhi Legislative Assembly election. "The review meeting with enforcement agencies is currently underway to ensure smooth conduct of the election," Election Commission of India tweeted.

Minister Tatkare to represent Maha in 2-day GST Conference in Rajasthan from December 20

Nagpur, Dec 18 (UNI): Minister Aditi Tatkare will represent Maharashtra in the two-day GST Conference to be held at Jaipur in Rajasthan from December 20.

Ahead of this conference, she took a detailed review of GST (goods and sales tax) from the officials in the meeting held at the state assembly here on Wednesday.

State Tax Commissioner

Ashish Sharma, Sales Tax Minister, Ashish Sharma, Sales Tax Deputy Commissioner Nand Kumar Dighe and others were present in this meeting.

At this time, Ms Tatkare took information about the reforms suggested by the state of Maharashtra in the

previously held GST conference, reforms to be proposed, exemptions to be given to various industries and entities in

taxes as well as simplicity in tax structure and clear definition of taxpayers.

The meeting discussed about tax exemptions given to sectors like electric vehicles, insurance premiums, agricultural products.

The minister was also informed about the tax reduction and tax increase to be done in some areas, leading to the difference in revenue.

Bomb threat to Kalyan railway station turns out to be false alarm after intensive search

Thane, Dec 18 (PTI): A bomb threat targeting Kalyan railway station in Thane district turned out to be a hoax after an intensive search of the premises by security agencies that lasted for nearly three hours on early Wednesday, police said. The bomb threat call, originating from New Delhi, was received at the Central Police Station in Ullhasnagar around 1 a.m. but nothing suspicious was found during the search, an official said.

The caller claimed a person has informed him that Kalyan station on the Central Railway (CR) route on Mumbai's outskirts is going to be "blown up", and then disconnected, he said.

The Central Police Station immediately alerted the station manager at Kalyan.

Railway Protection Force (RPF), Government Railway Police (GRP), and canine detection squads to assess the threat, informed the official.

Within minutes, multiple police teams arrived at Kalyan station and conducted a thorough inspection. Over the next two to three hours, security personnel meticulously combed through the premises and surrounding areas, searching for any signs of explosives or suspicious activity, he said.

Railway services were not disrupted during this period, according to the official.

"No bombs, explosives, or suspicious individuals were found during the search," confirmed a senior police officer.

MPSC declare results of all pending examinations on time

Nagpur, Dec 18 (UNI) Expressing grave concern over inordinate delay in declaration of the results of the Civil Service Officer's

main examination conducted by the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC), member Satish Chavan on

Wednesday demanded that MPSC should declare the results of all the pending examinations on time.

Making a special mention in the upper house in this regard, he said that

the MPSC conducted the main examination for 495 posts of Maharashtra Civil Service Officer on January 28, 2024 but its results have been pending for last 11 months.

Nearly 5,000 candidates from the state appeared for this examination, he mentioned.

Now, the year is coming to end, but the results of the main examination have not been declared as yet, he pointed. Recruitment is not being done despite there are numerous vacancies in many departments of the government, he informed. Also, in those departments where recruitment has been done was not done on time, the MLC noted.

As the results are not being declared on time by the MPSC, there is growing dissatisfaction among the candidates who appeared for the examination, he mentioned.

Senior Advocate Iqbal Chagla passes away

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI) Senior advocate Iqbal Chagla has passed away on Monday afternoon after a period of ill health. He was 86. A large number of legal fraternity and members from the various fields attended the funeral, which took place as per Parsi rites. Chagla, the son of Mahomedali Currin Chagla, the first Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court of independent India, died due to prolonged illness. Chagla, father of sitting Bombay High Court judge Justice Riyaz Chagla, served as the president of the Bombay Bar

Association (BBA) three times. Born in 1939, he earned an MA in History and Law from Cambridge University before beginning his practice at the Bombay High Court. He trained under the renowned Kharshedji Hormasji Bhabha and was designated a senior advocate in 1979. Between 1990 and 1999, he served as the BBA president and held other prominent roles, including as a member of the Executive Committee of the Bar Association of India and the National Legal Services Authority (NLSA). Despite being offered a judgeship three—twice by the

Bombay High Court and his court demeanour, his fairness, and his integrity. He has been a champion of defending human rights and a fierce fighter for upholding the rule of law. Aditya Thackeray disappointed with central govt on naming New Mumbai airport

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI) Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Aditya Thackeray on Monday expressed his disappointment with the BJP-led central government for not granting approval to name the Navi Mumbai airport after late leader DB Patil, a proposal sent in June, 2022.

The previous Sena-UBT led Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government had decided to name it "Loknete Swargiya DB Patil International Airport". In a message on X, Thackeray said, "It is the birth anniversary of D B Patil. In June 2022, the MVA government cabinet decided to name the Navi Mumbai International Airport as Shri DB Patil International Airport and sent the recommendation to the Union government. The current status is that the cabinet decision is still pending approval from the union government." He questioned whether such pendency was normal for the BJP-led Central government or it was because they wished to "insult" Maharashtra.

Congress launches campaign across Maharashtra on 75th anniversary of the Constitution

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI): Accusing the BJP of "disrespecting" the Constitution and its architect B.R. Ambedkar, the Congress has launched a campaign across Maharashtra on the 75th anniversary of the all-important document, vowing to uphold the values of social justice and equality, an official said on Monday.

The Congress, which has organised the campaign under the slogan 'Jai Babu, Jai Bhim, Jai Constitution', said it is committed to protecting the honour of Ambedkar and the Constitution. The campaign, which started at the national level on January 3, will conclude on January 26 with a grand rally at Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Nagar, Mahu, in Madhya Pradesh. Maharashtra Congress president Nana Patole said in a statement. On the 75th anniversary of the Constitution, the 'Jai Babu, Jai Bhim, Jai Constitution' rally has been

organised at the state, district and block levels on January 26. To strengthen the campaign, a nationwide public relations initiative 'Save Constitution National Walk' will be launched from January 26 this year to January 26 next year. Patole informed that all office bearers of the state Congress, former MLAs, MPs, all office bearers and workers of its various cells and departments will participate in the campaign.

Trial of Badlapur school sexual assault case should be fast-tracked: HC

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI) :The Bombay High Court on Monday said the trial in last year's Badlapur school sexual assault case should be fast-tracked and conducted expeditiously as the victim girls are very young. A HC Division bench, comprising Justices Revati Mohite Dere and Neela Gokhale, made the observation after public prosecutor Hiten Venegaonkar informed the bench, that the investigation was complete, the chargesheet had been filed, and the trial was set to proceed. The High Court had taken suo motu cognisance of the incident after it emerged that the local Badlapur police had delayed lodging a First Information Report (FIR). In August last year, a male attendant sexually assaulted the two girls—aged four and five—inside the toilet of their school located in Badlapur area of Maharashtra's Thane district.

During the hearing, the court also noted that, as mandated under the POCSO Act, a female prosecutor would need to be present when the girls are examined. Venegaonkar confirmed that a female prosecutor had been appointed to assist the special public prosecutor in the case.

BEST bus services hit as contract workers go on strike

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI) A strike by contract workers at a private bus depot here disrupted some Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport (BEST) bus services Monday morning. Sources indicate that 110 buses from the Pratiksha Nagar depot and 100 from the Dharavi depot were affected. According to BEST officials, the strike was triggered by an incident involving a pregnant lady conductor who was allegedly insulted by employees of the lease operator. They went on a flash protest after 8 a.m. This impacted about 80-100 bus routes that these buses ply on, mainly towards south Mumbai, central and eastern suburbs," a BEST official stated.

Model robbed of cash, jewellery worth Rs 15 lakhs

Mumbai, Jan 13 (UNI) The apartment of a South Indian model in a posh housing society here was looted of cash and gold worth Rs 15.3 lakh while she was away visiting her hometown in Hubli, Karnataka, official said here on Monday. The N.M. Joshi Marg police have registered a case and launched an

investigation. The victim Nikita Nil Barad, who resides alone in the apartment at the India Bulls Sky Forest complex, had left for her hometown in the second week of December last year. On returning this month, she discovered the theft and upon checking her cupboard, found gold jewellery and cash missing. The burglary is believed to have taken place during her absence. Police suspect that the thieves, aware of her prolonged absence, took advantage of

the empty flat. Police have registered a case under relevant sections of the BNS Act. Senior officers have taken serious note of the incident and ordered a detailed inquiry. Crime Branch teams are assisting local police in analysing CCTV footage to identify the suspects and expedite their arrest
